



# The FWS needs more than double its current funding for the ESA.

Here's where that would go.

## Recovery


- Recovery programming covers recovery plan development, implementation and 5-year reviews
- Current: \$81 million
- Needed: \$196 million

**480** Species lack final recovery plans

## Conservation and Restoration

- Candidate species get part of their funding under Conservation and Restoration
- Current: \$21 million
- Needed: 8.4 million

**23** Candidate species need protections under the ESA



## Listing

- 350 species await listing decisions as part of the FWS 7 year workplan
- Current: \$11 million
- Needed: \$51 million

**155** The number of species needing listing decisions in FY2020

## Planning and Consultation

- Protects species from actions that would jeopardize their existence or adversely modify their critical habitat
- Current: \$99 million
- Needed: \$130 million

**\$0** Currently dedicated to compliance monitoring

## CESCF

- The Cooperative Endangered Species Conservation Fund supports states for conservation on private lands
- Current: \$0
- Needed: \$100 million

**\$0** Budgeted for CESCF in FY2019
